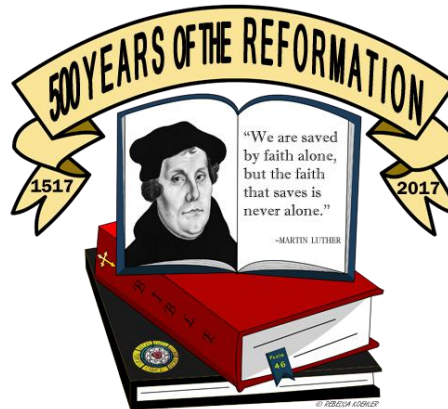
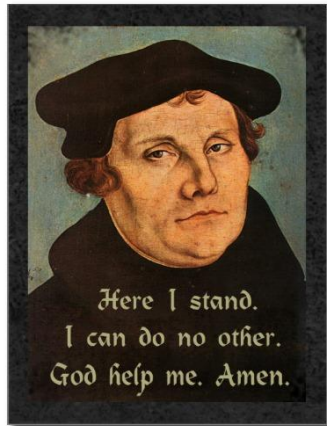


Luther's Birthday/Fall of the Wall

Airfare not included, but approximately \$1,000 from NYC/Newark.

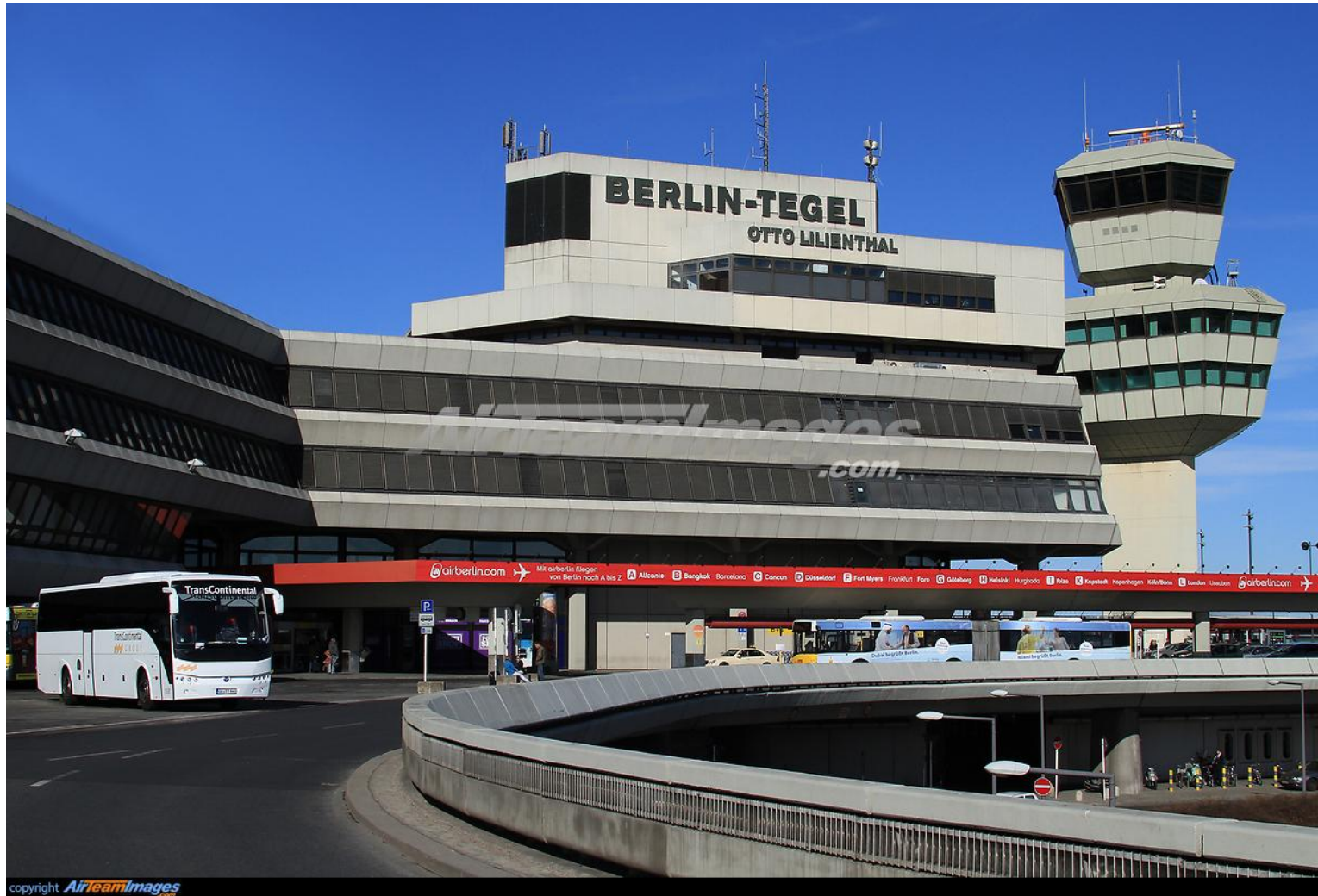

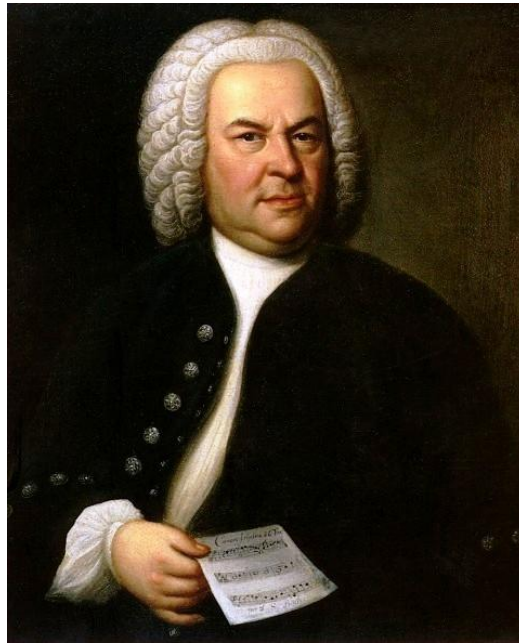

3. PROGRAM REQUIRES THE READING AND DISCUSSION OF THE BOOK. YOU WILL BE PROVIDED WITH THE BOOK, *Luther and the Stories of God* by Rev. Dr. Robert Kolb AND ASKED TO READ A FEW SELECTED CHAPTERS FOR THE TOUR.
4. THE TOUR REQUIRES WALKING AND CLIMBING AND THERE ARE NO ACCOMMODATIONS FOR DISABILITIES WITH TRANSPORTATION AND HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS.
5. CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION AWARDED BY THE NJ DISTRICT OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH. PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED WITH APPROVAL BEFORE SUBMITTING PAYMENT.
6. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL. CHILDREN AGES 12-18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR PARENT. (NOTE: Some evening activities include beer and wine)
